



Grant Burge 5th Generation Barossa Shiraz

Grant Burge is a 5th generation Barossa Vigneron. The history of the Burge family and their long association with winemaking in the region can be traced back to March 1855, when noted tailor John Burge immigrated to the Barossa with his wife Eliza and their two sons Meshach and Henry.

Grant Burge 5th Generation Shiraz is a deep, yet soft, red wine from Barossa - raspberry and blackberry aromas complemented by spice, vanilla and a hint of coffee.

Cool, wet conditions during December, January and February with warmer conditions to follow resulted in a very late vintage. Extended hang time on the vines with increased canopy density due to the wet spring and summer allowed the fruit to attain excellent flavour ripeness while maintaining good levels of natural acidity.



APPEARANCE

Deep dark purple with purple/red hues.

NOSE

Lifted raspberry and blackberry fruit with hints of dark jube like characters complimented by spice, subtle vanilla, mocha and coffee bean

PALATE

Bright red/black fruits in the mid palate balanced with integrated fine long tannins. Hints sweetness and spice from the oak
