

2012 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The Coonawarra Series Cabernet Sauvignon is a vibrant and stylish wine with generous, mouth filling fruit flavours encompassing a classic structure.

The inaugural vintage of the Coonawarra Series Cabernet Sauvignon was released in September 2013.

Made from fruit grown on red and shallow transition soils in the earlier-ripening north western part of Coonawarra, the grapes were picked at optimum ripeness following an exceptional growing season in 2012. Fermentation took place in static fermenters before maturation in French oak followed by final blending and bottling.

The Coonawarra Series Cabernet Sauvignon is made in a ripe and generous style, yet with enough restraint to display distinct varietal and regional characteristics.

Colour: deep rich red with a dark purple core

Aroma: blackcurrant, dark chocolate, black forest cake, violets and hints of black liquorice.

Palate: dark choc-mint, expansive soft palate with delicious forest fruits, elegant structure and supportive fine grain tannins.
