2014 Old Vines Grenache Shiraz Mataro

Sourced from the undulating red earths of the western Barossa Valley, this hearty red blend encompasses all of the rich, ripe, savoury flavours for which the Barossa is famed.

Deep red with purple hues, the wines high-toned aromas of dark fruits and spice are all supported by a rich core of red fruits, liquorice, saddle leather and black pepper. The palate offers a soft latent richness and silken-like texture with subtle notes of black cherries, plum and spice- all neatly wound by a taught spine of acidity and ripe supple tannins. Although very enjoyable already the 2014 Grenache/Shiraz/Mataro will continue to flourish over the next 5-7 years.

VARIETAL: 62% Grenache, 22% Shiraz & 16% Mataro

REGIONS: North Western Barossa Valley

HARVEST: March, April 2014

ALCOHOL: 15% Alc/Vol

FERMENTATION: Like all wines in the Torbreck stable, the fruit is sourced from

hand harvested and hand tended plots throughout the North

Western Barossa Valley. It is fermented in our cement, wooden

and inox vats for 6-7 days and then basket pressed to well

seasoned hogsheads and French oak foudres for 24 months. It is

bottled without the use of either fining or filtration.
