




CASARENA S.V.

ORIGIN

Designation of origin: Agrelo, Luján de Cuyo. Mendoza, Argentina.

Planted: 2007

Training and pruning system: bilateral cordon spur pruning.

Irrigation system: drip system. Yield: 7,000 kilos per hectare.

Altitude: 918 m. (3011.81 feet above sea level).

Type of soil: clay loam.

Climate: arid continental.

VINTAGE 2013

Weather conditions during harvest were optimal, what was favorable for the elaboration of wines with a good typicity. The ripening phase was a little longer than usual, what resulted in an ideal fruit quality.

COMPOSITION

Varietal: Petit Verdot 100%

WINEMAKING

Grapes were manually harvested during the last week in April. The fruit was taken to the winery where berries and bunches were selected according to their quality to undergo afterwards a pre-fermentation cold maceration. Indigenous yeasts triggered fermentation and grapes were micro vinified. Extraction procedures (pigeage) were manually done to preserve the most delicate aromas and flavors of the grapes.

BARREL AGING AND AGING POTENTIAL IN BOTTLE

Barrel aging: 12 months in new French oak barrels.

Potential: more than 10 years.

ANALYSIS

Alcohol: 14% Vol. Acidity: expressed in tartaric acid 6.1 g / l. PH: 3,7"

TASTING NOTES

Deep red, bright. In the nose red and black fruit with mint notes, chocolate and spices. In the mouth, it is expressive and multi-layered, powerful, and has an excellent volume. Intense, with a long and complex finish.
