Producer: The Axel Pauly estate cultivates a total area of 9 hectares, the majority of is located at the top sites of Lieserer Niederberg-Helden and Bernkastel-Kueser Kardinalsberg. The vineyards are all facing south or south-west, have a typical slate soil and a slope of up to 80 degrees in steepness! The striking characteristic of all of Axel's wines is the purity, crystalline character, length and minerality of all of his wines.

Soil & Climate: grey and blue slate, cool climate

Vintage: Challenging vintage: rainy and moist warmth in the early summer months, that led to some infections. But sunny late summer weather and excellent ripeness of the remaining grapes.

Vinification: hand-picked, maceration for 10 hours, spontaneous fermentation in stainless steel with natural yeast, maturation on fine yeast for 4-5 months

Alcohol level: 11.0% vol.

Residual sugar: 17.0 g/l

Acid level: 7.4 g/l
