## 2018 WATERVALE RIESLING

### BACKGROUND

Mount Horrocks Wines is operated by proprietor/winemaker Stephanie Toole, who restricts production to approximately 3,500 cases per annum in order to achieve her aims of quality and single vineyard expression.

### VINEYARDS

Hand picked from estate owned single vineyard in Watervale, Clare Valley. Certified Australian Organic (ACO) wine from 2014.

### VINIFICATION

The hand picked fruit is cooled and crushed destemmed with only the free run juice used. No finings. Fermented without oak by neutral yeasts to completely dry to allow pure expression of the variety and single vineyard site. Suitable for vegans and vegetarians.

### TASTING NOTES

Lime green tints to the edge of the glass indicate this wine's youthful vitality which shows, too, in its aroma which is delicate, floral and also reminiscent of limes.

No surprise then that the citrus tones form the base of its taste too, wrapped around a silky mountain stream minerality, juicy, lime blossom spring florals and a long, crisp, cleansing finish. Simply divine. Will repay a decade or more in the cellar, if, unlike this taster, you possess the restraint.
