BAROSSA VALLEY

2015 Old Vines Grenache Mataro Shiraz

Sourced from the undulating red earths of the western Barossa Valley, this hearty red blend encompasses all of the rich, ripe, savoury flavours for which the Barossa is famed.

Deep red with bright hues, the wines high-toned aromas of dark plum, cherry and spice are all supported by a rich core of red fruits, liquorice, dried meat and black pepper. The palate offers a soft latent richness and silken-like texture with subtle notes of ripe black berries and spice- all neatly wound by a taught spine of acidity and generous tannins. Although very enjoyable already the 2015 Grenache/ Mataro/ Shiraz will continue to flourish over the next 5-7 years.

VARIETAL:	84% Grenache, 8% Mataro & 8% Shiraz
REGIONS:	North Western Barossa Valley
HARVEST:	March, April 2015
ALCOHOL:	15% Alc/Vol
FERMENTATION:	Like all wines in the Torbreck stable, the fruit is sourced from hand harvested and hand tended plots throughout the North Western Barossa Valley. It is fermented in our cement and wooden vats for 6-7 days and then basket pressed to well seasoned hogsheads and French oak foudres for 24 months. It is bottled without the use of either fining or filtration.
