

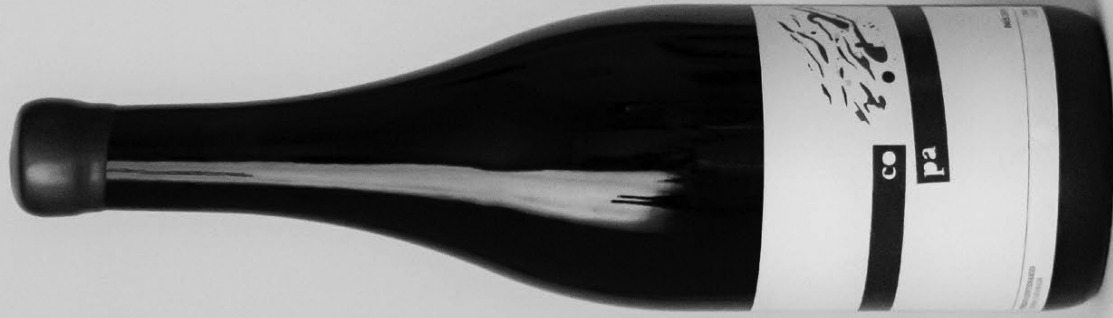

The first wines produced in Chile were made with país grapes during the 1550s and Itata was the main Chilean wine-producing area for almost 300 years. Itata grape growers stood resilient the passage of time, transcending the farming tradition of his old vines.

Nowadays, País (as Itata itself) has flourished around the world due to a re-discovery of its ancient wine tradition and the uniqueness of its old vineyards and wines. We as winemakers firmly believe in the amazing potential of País grapes, introducing a wine with personality, long finish, and complexity.



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WINE SPECIFICATIONS

Origin (D.O.) | Ránquil, Itata Valley

Variety | País 100%

Vineyard | Is located in San Ignacio de Palomares, Ránquil, Itata Valley. Very old bush estimated in 150 years old over granitic soils with 30% slope in the coastal mountain range at 39km from the Pacific Ocean. Dry Farmed (no irrigation), without rootstock and trained and trained in gobelet.

Yield | 3.500 Kg/Ha

Harvest | Handpicked in small 15kg boxes

Winemaking | The grapes were destemmed and put in rauli wood open tanks where slow alcoholic fermentation took place during 18 days with soft pumps over avoiding over-extraction. Malolactic fermentation and aging ageing in concrete tanks and old oak barrels for 18 months.

Production | 2.954 bottles

Tasting Notes | Red fruit aromas as cherries and wild herbs notes with an earthy hint. On the palate shows firms and gentle tannins, structured and balanced, an elegant and complex wine that reminds Chile's south native forest.
