Pinot Noir 2020
D.O. Traiguén

Vintage 2020:

Rainy winter, dry and warm spring and a moderately warm summer translated in very healthy grapes and balanced yields, giving wines of concentration, depth, and purity.

The significant amount of rain during winter (482 mm) provided excellent water supply in the soils for the vineyard growth, compensating the rather dry and warm conditions of the spring. The good vigour of the plants and the moderately high yields helped to curb the advance of the maturity of the grapes during summer, preserving the aromas, acidity and flavors, delivering wines of great fruit intensity and purity.

Los Suizos Vineyard:

- **Region:** Malleco – D.O. Traiguén
- **Geology:** pyroclastic volcanic breccia of andesite lava.
- **Soils:** ancient soils of volcanic origin with clay to loam texture (Red Clay Soils).
- **Climate:** Mediterranean with temperate summer and rainy winter. Abundant average rainfall (1,084mm/year) allows dry farming.

Winemaking:

- **Harvest dates:** March 20th to 30th
- **Varietal composition:** 100% Pinot Noir
- **Vinification:** native yeasts and 20% whole cluster in fermentation
- **Aging:** 15 months in French barrels (300L), 38% new.

Production: 4.102 bottles

Tasting Notes

Cherry red in color, the nose is intense and extremely pure with aromas of red fruit, such as cherry, rosehip and raspberry, with floral aromas of violet and rose. On the palate it is long, concentrated and deep, with textured tannins, refreshing



acidity and notes of cherry, pomegranate, graphite and chalk. Purity, personality and tipicity define this version of our Los Primos 2020.
