VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Sunraysia regions have a climate well suited for growing vines, with warm summer days and plenty of sunshine, allowing ripe fruit flavours and sugars to develop. In 2021 we had warm days, cool nights and little or no rain. This led to excellent ripening conditions resulting in bright, ripe fruit.

VITICULTURE & WINEMAKING

The grapes are grown on vines aged 15-20 years, planted in calcareous earth. They are harvested into temperature controlled stainless steel tanks where they undergo fermentation. No animal based fining agents were added making the wines vegan friendly.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: Pale straw.

Aroma: The nose shows wonderfully aromatic notes of citrus zest, lychees, kiwi fruit and musk, all bursting out of the glass.

Palate: Mouth filling sweetness dominates the palate, with balanced acid and a fine spritz. Rich flavours of apricot, sherbet and grapey muscat deliver a classic Moscato palate. A wine made for fun and for any occasion.
