



Baettig Vino de Viñedo “Los Parientes”  
Pinot Noir 2022  
D.O. Traiguén

*Vintage 2022:*

Moderately cool and late season, with the heat summation below the historical average. The winter was relatively dry (400 mm). Dry and cool spring with significant frosts in September and October led to very small crop.

The start of the spring was cold with a dry September (45 mm of rain). November and December were also dry allowing a good fruit set of the reduced number of clusters. January was rainy (60 mm) and cool, February showed average temperatures whereas March and April were cold and rainy, particularly April with 184 mm of precipitation. This long and late season of small production translated in wines of great intensity and typicity along with excellent tension and concentration.

*Los Suizos Vineyard:*

- **Region:** Malleco – D.O. Traiguén
- **Geology:** pyroclastic volcanic breccia of andesite lava.
- **Soils:** ancient soils of volcanic origin with clay to loam texture (red clay soils).
- **Climate:** Mediterranean with temperate summer and rainy winter. Abundant average rainfall (1,084mm/year) allows dry farming.
- **Harvest dates:** March 31<sup>st</sup> to April 18<sup>th</sup>

*Winemaking:*

- **Varietal composition:** 100% Pinot Noir
- **Vinification:** native yeasts and 10% whole cluster in fermentation
- **Aging:** 8 months in French barrels. 14% new (300L).
- **Bottled:** November 29<sup>th</sup> 2022

*Production:* 13.205 bottles

*Tasting Notes:*

Brown stems with a hint of blackcurrants, mulberries, violets, rose hips and a hint of licorice. Medium- to full-bodied palate with a fleshy mid-palate and fine tannins. Quite intense yet vibrant. Great drinkability. Drink now (JS).
