HARVEST (VENDIMIA) 2020

During the spring of 2019, we began to notice widespread, clusters with fewer grains, which resulted in a drop in performance between 20-30% as expected due to the spring frosts. Summer 2020 was dry and hot, with marked high temperatures, which led to the acceleration of the ripening of the grapes and compressing the harvest exclusively in the month of March. Although it was an advanced ripening harvest, the decrease in performance brought about greater concentration and structure in the wines, resulting in wines of great complexity and aging potential.

VINIFICATION

Harvest by polygons, where the establishment factors of these polygons is determined by: presence (form and youth) of the gypsum on the ground, the profile of the soil, solar exposure of the rows (since there are about 7) and slope of the vineyard. Separate vinification is done of those polygons and their subsequent aging in barrels where does malolactic fermentation.

TASTING NOTES

Deep, bright purple-red color, with violet flashes. In nose presents a marked mineral profile characteristic of this estate, as well as those typical notes of the varietal: plum and fresh red fruit; is complemented by a slight contribution of spice provided by the native flora of the zone. In the mouth, its freshness and friendly tannins stand out. It is a complex and balanced wine, with a persistent finish.
