WINE FROM D.O. BIERZO 2022

EN EL CAMINO

Our village wine. En el camino is our purest and freshest expression of the D.O. Bierzo. With grapes from the entire region, harvested from different vineyards that are over 50 years old in the southern area of Ponferrada, at different heights and soil compositions, this wine is made up mainly of Mencía (90%), but it also contains varieties such as Palomino, Doña Blanca and Alicante Bouschet.

- Appellation of origin: D.O. Bierzo.
- Towns: Magaz de Abajo, Cacabelos, Arganza, Villafranca del Bierzo.
- Grape variety: Mencía
- Vineyards: free-standing head-trained 80-year old vines. Dryland farming irrigation.
- Organic vinegrowing practices.
- Soil: Clay and Quarz.
- Orientación: North, East, West.
- Vineyard extension: 10 hectares.
- Altitude: 200-500 masl.
- Harvest time: September.

Winemaking details: spontaneous fermentation with 30% whole cluster. Short post-fermentative maceration and aging for 1 year in 50% wooden and 50% stainless steel vats.

- Bottling: October 2022.
- Production: 30.000 bottles.
- Alcohol: 12,5%
- Total acidity: 5,05 g/l
- Comments about the vintage: 2022 was a super early year, with a mild spring and a dry summer, which gave us wines with a lot of fruit, expressiveness, very noble and frank from minute one.
