Wine of origin Swartland

David & Nadia is a first generation family owned Swartland project and we are members of the Swartland Independent Producers. With family roots in the Swartland dating back to 1757, we focus on dry land farmed bush vines, soil diversity, climate and people of one region only.

In the vineyard we aim for biological farming whilst more vineyards are being farmed more organically year on year and in the cellar we work as natural as possible. It is all about the soil and vineyards after all. We believe in a pure, fresh and natural approach as style where site and soil are at work with minimal influence from a winemaking point of view.

We have been working with this Paardeberg dry land bush vine vineyard since almost the beginning of our own wines. The Paardeberg is home to us and to celebrate the mountain, its valleys and granitic soils (which is our main inspiration and focus in the cellar), we have done a small Langland Single Vineyard bottling. The vineyard was planted in 1971 in deep, white, sandy soils, facing east and tucked away with a valley on either side of the vineyard. The grapes ripen slower than our other pure granitic vineyard in the Siebritskloof, called Plat'bos. Langland is also a prominent contributor to our Chenin blanc and Aristargos bottlings. It is marked by tension, texture, freshness and salinity. This wine is also produced from a Certified Heritage Vineyard (CHV) and forms part of the Old Vine Project (OVP), as the vineyard exceeds 35 years in age.

Grapes are sorted by hand after it has been cooled off overnight. Grapes are whole bunch pressed and fermented and matured in 300 L French oak barrels for 11 months before being racked and bottled. Bottle maturation of eight months take place prior to release.

The Swartland is known for extremely warm summers with a low average winter rainfall. On the west, the Swartland borders on the Atlantic ocean and on the east inland by mountain ranges. Due to this location, a large diurnal shift is observed where the average daytime temperatures are much higher than the average night time temperatures. All of our vineyards are however inland and our climate is considered to be mediterranean.
